

K. Out-of-town Events:

Students are representatives of the school at out-of-town events. The conduct of the students at such events determines the reputation of the school and of its students. Therefore, students are expected to exhibit good behavior at away events, as well as at home.

Students attending inter-scholastic events and using transportation provided by the school are expected to return using the SAME method of transportation. Parents are allowed to take students home by speaking in person at the event to the chaperone of the fan bus or the coach of the team. Team members and cheerleaders representing the school will use transportation provided by or arranged for by the school. At no time will a student involved in an activity be allowed to drive his/her own vehicle to the event.

Students riding home with someone other than their parents or immediate family must make arrangements prior to the event.
