

I. Public Use of School

The school is a community effort; thus the building may be used by the district patrons when it does not interfere with regular school classes or scheduled activities. The use of the school building and equipment by adult groups shall be scheduled through the superintendent's office. The building must be properly supervised during such public use.

Facilities must be left in the same condition as which they were found. Any damage to the property will require a payment of damage by the group using the school facilities.

Independent basketball practices and games will be permitted in the gym, provided players are from the local school district and chaperoned by an adult approved by the superintendent.

All public dances must be approved by the School Board. Prior to approval a list of chaperones and how the dance is to be policed must be provided. At least 2 people with necessary enforcement authority to issue citations and make arrests must be used to police each dance, one inside and one outside.

Use of school by private individuals must be approved by the school board. Any insurance premium that may be necessary must be paid by the private party.
