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With Montpelier High School's flex mod schedule for the 2019-2020 school year, there will be times when students in grades 10 –12 will not be required to be in school. There will be a student lounge available for them and they will also be able to be in other spaces such as the cafeteria and the gym if supervised.

This is only true, however, if the student is not getting lower than a C in any class, if they are completely caught up in online classes, and if they have not suffered any disciplinary action in the last week. It is also only true during resource times and homeroom – times which a regular class is not being held.

The logic behind this is two-fold:

1. If the student is not engaged in coursework and is not struggling in coursework, there would seem to be no reason for that student to be in school.
2. It's motivation for students to be successful in classes.

Motivation is greatly enhanced if the student is not only able to be out of class but is also able to leave school grounds. This may include the student driving home or elsewhere. We do know that kids sometimes have a difficult time handling freedoms. As such, we deemed it necessary to provide this document.

A parental signature on this form with a check by the 'yes' statement indicates that his or her child is able to leave school grounds when deemed acceptable by Montpelier School's flex mod plan.

Without a parental signature in place on this form or with a signature and the check by the 'no' statement, students may not leave school grounds and if they do, disciplinary action will be required.
