

SCHOOL YEAR & CALENDAR

A school calendar for the ensuing school year shall be prepared by the Superintendent and presented to the Board each year by a date designated by the Board. The Board may receive input from teachers, students, and the community before final adoption of the calendar. Any changes in the calendar after adoption shall be subject to board approval. The school calendar shall:

1. List the opening and closing dates of the school year. A school year shall consist of the minimum number of days required by state law and consisting of 175 student contact days unless otherwise determined by the Board.
2. In emergency situations provide for the necessity of school cancellation. More than one school cancellation will result in extra missed days being postponed until a scheduled storm day. If more than three days are missed, the school board does have the authority to forgive days dependent on the ND Century Code 15.1-27-23.
3. List professional development days for teachers and administrators. The Board shall schedule professional development days in accordance with law.
4. Set forth days of attendance for students, holiday and vacation periods, parent-teacher conference days, and other dates of importance to the staff and public.
